

FORTLAX

Fortlax is the largest commercial data center in northern Sweden. Once built by the Swedish military, Fortlax today offers a certified state-of-the-art facility for long term storage of magnetic media and efficient data center operations.

Storage on-tap is readily available today in a 14 000 sq feet data center. The possibility to expand into a 91 acre adjacent area opens up excellent opportunities for building custom solutions and additional capacity.

The facility is entirely redundant in terms of power, cooling and connectivity. A 10kV power line with a current capacity of 2 MW is connected to the on site substation. The facility uses 100% hydro power from nearby Lule River. In addition, the facility is backed up by diesel driven generators with fuel storage capacity for several weeks. The whole building is built to withstand attacks with firearms and gas and is shielded against spurious transmissions and electromagnetic pulse.

The location, just south of the Polar Circle, allows for free cooling almost all year round. Fortlax is also located in Sweden's most attractive electricity tax area.

Redundant single mode gigabit fibre is available on site from 2 different directions. Fortlax is the node in the local city fiber network and Sweden's largest infrastructure operators and service providers have termination points close to the site. Dark fiber or wavelength can be leased.
